

# HOLY TRINITY CATHOLIC CHURCH ADDITION & RENOVATION

In celebration of their 50th anniversary, the parishioners at Holy Trinity Catholic Church desired to renovate and expand their church to establish a sign and symbol of faith for the next 50 years and beyond.

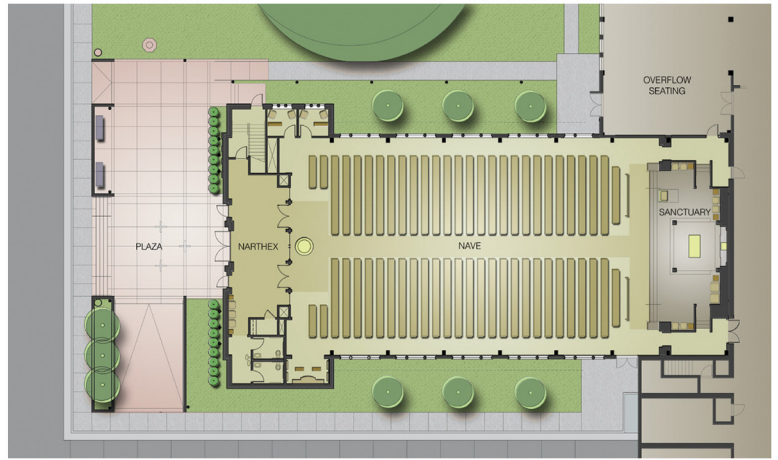
The primary goals of the project were to increase the beauty of the liturgical environment, and to expand seating capacity. The new design creates a more worthy space for communal worship and celebration of Holy Mass.

The project includes a complete interior renovation and a significant new addition to West front of the church. The design provides a new Narthex, an expanded Nave, a new choir loft, confessionals, and devotional side chapels. Light pours in from above, where the central portion of the existing roof was raised five feet to allow for new clerestory windows.

The Sanctuary has been completely transformed into a rich focus for the liturgical life of the parish. A new baldachino marks the location of the new Altar and Altar of Repose. A dramatic arch sets off the Sanctuary as sacred space.

Future stained glass is planned for all windows in the Nave and Narthex, and spaces for devotional artwork have been incorporated for current and future generations.

Integration Design Group was responsible not only for the architectural design, but also for the custom pews, furniture, marble liturgical elements, and decorative painting as well.
